RAINBOW WEEK

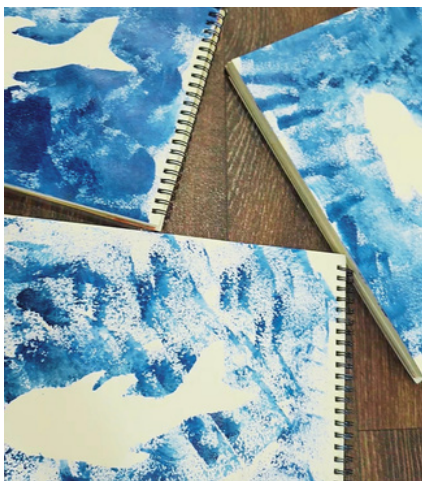


"Every colour has a story, and together they create a beautiful rainbow."

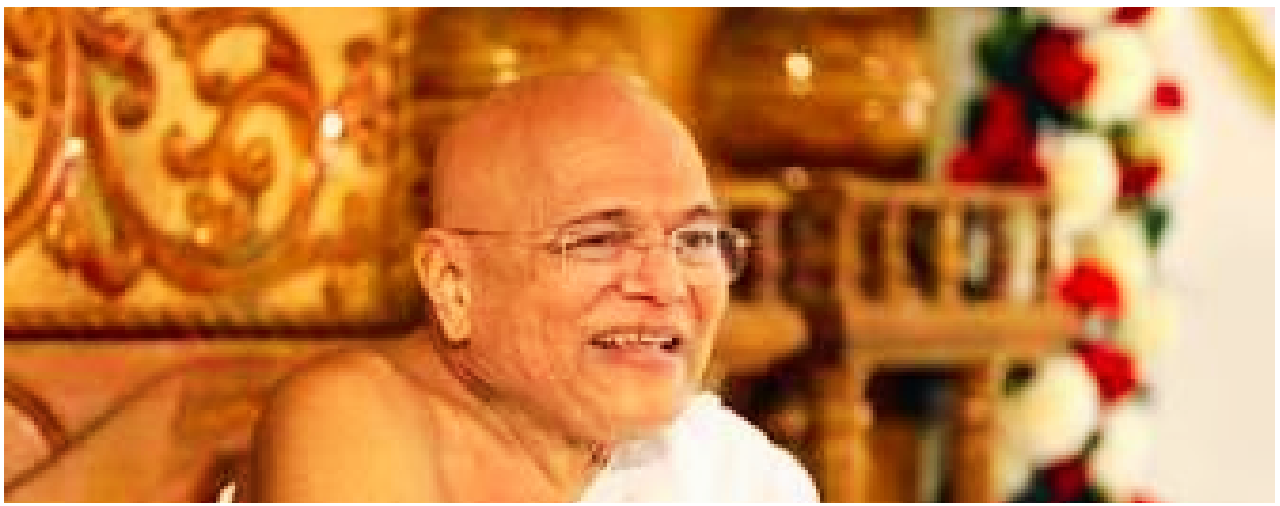

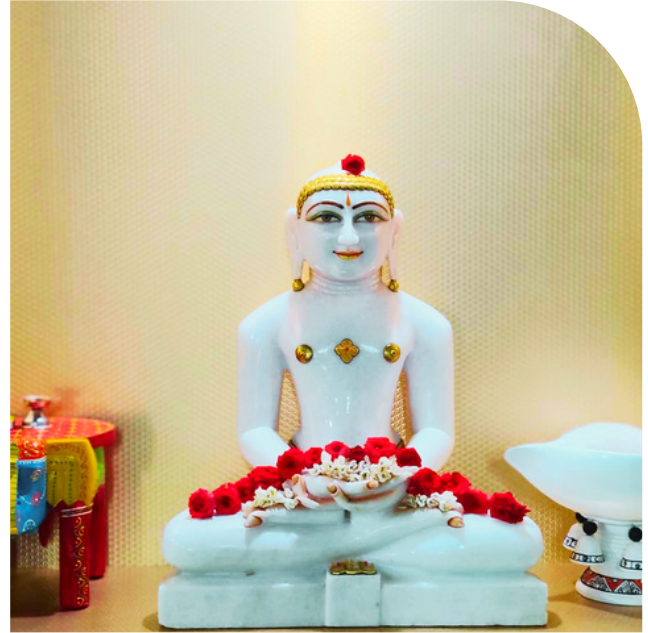
